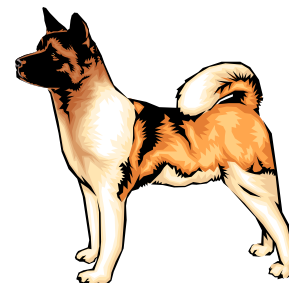

RE: Dogs Project Information Letter



The 4-H Dog Show will be held Saturday, July 8 beginning promptly at 9:30 a.m. on the Hocking County Fairgrounds. The show is open to any 4-H member in Hocking County enrolled in a dog project. Note: remember to bring your project book with you, especially if you are entered in a dog care class.

Vaccinations must be given by a licensed, accredited veterinarian. All 4-Hers must have a certificate of vaccination and a license for their dog available for examination at the show. Note that there are specific date requirements for vaccinations listed on the forms. Pet records or kennel cards will NOT be accepted. Dogs must be licensed in their county of residence. Members not meeting these requirements will not be permitted to show.

Note: Registration forms for Ohio State Fair Dog Show and Poster Contest are included in the 40-page Hocking County 4-H Dog Program Handbook that was given to every dog club. The Table of Contents of that handbook is attached. Refer to that handbook in your club meetings as needed.
