

## Goat Skillathon

### Sell or Hold

### Practice Activity

Today is August 14, 2025

You are a meat goat producer and operate a 250 head feeder goat feed lot. As a way to keep track of goats that have been injured or treated you sort them into a hospital or “sick pen”. Several goats in the pen appear to have reached their market ready weight and have recovered from their problems. You want to send as many goats as possible to market in the **morning** at 10AM and need to make sure the withdrawal times are over. Using the information in this scenario and the information provided on the treatment record.

First fill in the “date and time withdrawal complete” on the treatment record chart for each of the four treated goats listed.

Then, sort the 5 goats in your “sick pen” into two groups:

- a. Those that can be sold tomorrow (SELL)
- b. Those that should be held to be sold at a later date. (HOLD)

NOTE: The sick pen is for goats with any sort of problem requiring special attention. There may be goats in this pen that have not received any medication.

Only four goats were treated, but you have 5 goats to go to market. The fifth goat was just placed in the sick pen for observation and recovered and did not receive any treatments.

**Correct Responses below:**

**HOLD**

ID N42 – Bore Wether – withdrawal is not complete until August 24, 2025, at 11AM

ID 22 - Bore Wether – withdrawal is not complete until August 24, 2025, at 10AM

**SELL**

ID N23 – Bore Doe – animal was treated but the withdrawal time was complete on August 14, 2025, at 10AM

ID N18 -Bore Wether – animal was treated but there was 0 Days withdrawal on the medication used.

ID 17 - Bore Wether – animal was not treated only placed in the sick pen for observation – has recovered.
