# **Project To Do List**

Members must follow the guidelines of:

- ☐ Complete 4-H Enrollment by 3/31
- □ Order Turkeys from an NPIP approved hatchery – Must in possession by 5/15
- ☐ Attend Quality Assurance training
- ☐ Order Broiler Chicks through Chieftain Feed and Supply by April 22 at 1PM
  - Each exhibitor must order a minimum of 6 chicks.
  - ☐ Pick up chicks same day they arrive in July.
- ☐ Complete project book and attend **Project**Judging and Skill-a-thon (July)
- □ Complete Fair Sign ups in August
- ☐ Bring exhibit to the fair at schedule haul in time.
- Must exhibit the project in designated class.
