

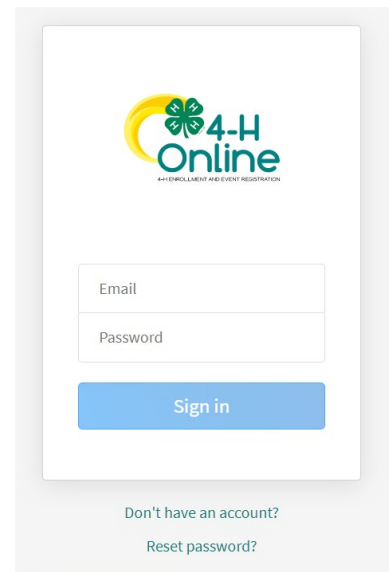
Member or Volunteer Re-Enrollment - All NEW families should contact the OSU Extension Office at 740-385-3222

For exiting 4-H members and volunteers. All existing 4-H members and volunteers will be responsible to enroll themselves beginning in 2021.

All NEW families should contact the OSU Extension Office at 740-385-3222.

If you have been enrolled in 4-H in Hocking County, you already have a 4-H Online family profile. You can access your account by following the directions below.

1. Go to <https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in>
2. Your **Log In** is the email address you gave the Extension Office last year. If you do not remember your family email – call the OSU Extension Office at 740-385-3222.
3. Choose **Reset password** – a temporary password and instructions will be sent to the email address associated with your family profile.
4. Once you have logged in to your family profile, you may review the **Member List**, add new family members, and complete your 4-H enrollment.

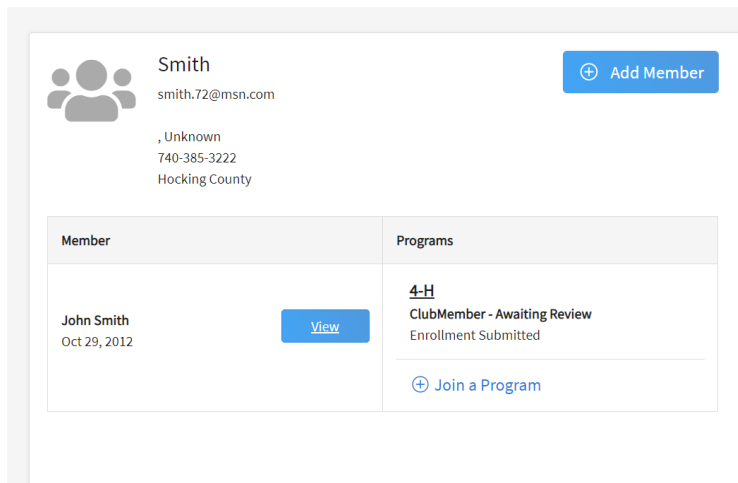

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Adding a Member to the Family Profile

Family profiles contain individual records for each youth or adult family member who participates in 4-H. These are called **Member Profiles**.

To add additional family members, click the blue **Add Member** button at the top of Member List. Each 4-H member or volunteer should only have one member profile – do not create an additional member profile for an existing member.

Fill in the member's name and birthdate. Click **Next** at the bottom of the page.

4-H Online will determine if the member is eligible to be enrolled as a Cloverbud, Youth or Adult based on birthdate.

Complete the information for the member, being sure to complete the required fields. Click **Next** at the bottom of the page.

Choose Participation

Youth should choose **I Want to Join 4-H as a New or Returning 4-H Member**.

Adults should choose **I Want to Join as a New or Returning 4-H Volunteer**.

Youth should choose the club they were enrolled in last year. If you are planning on changing clubs in 2021 – **Stop and call the OSU Extension Office before choosing your club in 4-H Online**.

Youth should choose their **projects** – make sure your club is the right club associated with your project. For instance, ... your project may be a Shooting Sports project and you would need to choose Hocking County Young Guns. Your second club may be Purple Clovers and your project with this club may be Market Rabbit.
