Holiday Greetings and a Happy New Year to all our 4-H Families!



Annual Volunteer Training

Returning 4-H volunteers are encouraged to complete the Youth Activities and Programs Policy (Policy 1.50) online. Instructions will be emailed after January 1, 2024. In-person Policy 1.50 training will only be offered **one** (1) time. Plan to attend the training on Saturday, February 17, if you do not want to do the online version.

All 4-H volunteers are required to attend one in-person annual volunteer training, in addition to Policy 1.50 training.

You must enroll in 4-HOnline prior to having your fingerprints submitted. The system will not be able to find you if you are not enrolled. Call Angie at 740-385-3222 if you need help. These will need to be completed by February 15, 2024.

Remember to submit your receipt and completed form to the Extension Office and we will file for a reimbursement for you.

2024 4-H Enrollment

Beginning January 2, 2024, all current and past 4-H members and volunteers may begin to enroll themselves in 4-HOnline 2.0.

Please refer to the information sheet with directions included in this mailing. Stop and Call our office if

- You cannot find your family profile. <u>DO NOT</u> create a new one.
- You want to change clubs in 2024
- You are a **new** member or volunteer
- You do not have access to the internet

New families should call our office **before** enrolling online. We will go over the process with them.

By allowing you access, you can update your club and project information as well as personal information (email, home address, phone, etc). This will ensure that you are properly enrolled in the county program and receive important news and updates such as newsletters, deadline information, and leadership opportunities.

- Traditional project members should choose all projects they are interested in taking before submitting enrollment. Once enrollments are approved you will not be able to go back and add projects.
- Cloverbuds must choose project 710 Cloverbud Activities. Cloverbuds may not enroll in any other project.

Projects cannot be changed/added after the March 29 enrollment deadline.

If your child(ren) belongs to a shared parenting household, you will need to decide a primary address for all materials that are to be mailed.

VOLUNTEERS – Please select the correct volunteer type when enrolling. Each club may only have one (1) organizational volunteer. If you have questions, please call the office.

The ability to change or update your information may be limited in certain fields of 4-HOnline 2.0. If you see information that is incorrect and you are not able to make changes, please call the Extension office for the changes to be made.

Enrollment deadline for 2024 is March 29!!!

Hocking County 4-H Cloverbud Club

OSU Extension, Hocking County will be hosting a county-wide 4-H Cloverbud Club beginning January 17, 2024. All youth, age 5 and in Kindergarten through age 8 and in second grade as of January 1, are eligible to participate. The club will meet from 6:30-7:30 pm in the Youth Center on January 17, 24; Feb. 7, 14, 28; March 6.



There is no cost to join. Meetings will include informal lessons, recreation, and snacks. Youth will be required to return a completed 4-H enrollment form and attend a minimum of four meetings to be considered a complete 4-H member for 2024. Members that meet the requirements will be invited to participate in Cloverbud interviews, Cloverbud Camp, and will receive an exhibitor pass for the 2024 Hocking County Fair.

Hocking County 4-H Horse Program

Members interested in completing a 2024 horse project (except Horseless Horse) must understand the following:

- There is an additional program fee of \$25 per member.
- Members must complete the EquiSTEP safety program online.
- Members enrolled in the Beginning Horse Management project may complete the project without an identified project animal under the following conditions:
 - 1) Members must have access to an animal
 - 2) Prohibited from participating in any state/county 4-H related horse shows (including fair)
 - 3) Must complete the EquiSTEP program
 - 4) Ohio Horse Program Rules form must be signed and returned to Extension Office
- Additional paperwork and information will be mailed to all members enrolled in a horse project in early April.
- Any member enrolled in a horse project (including Horseless Horse) in 2024 may submit a completed team
 member agreement to be a member of the Hocking County 4-H Horse Team. More information regarding 4-H
 Horse Team can be found at hocking.osu.edu under4-H Youth Development, then go to 4-H Forms and
 Applications. Horse information is toward the bottom of the page
- The Ohio 4-H Horse Rule Book will be updated as of January 2024 be sure to pick up a new edition.

Mandatory - Animal Quality Assurance Training

All 4-H and FFA members enrolled in the following livestock projects - beef, swine, sheep, goat, llama/alpaca, rabbit, and poultry - are required to attend one Quality Assurance class before May 24, 2024. This includes ALL projects in these species. (market, breeding, pet, etc...) All classes will be held at the Youth Center and RSVP is required.

2024 QA Training Dates:

Wednesday, March 13, 6-8 PM

Monday, April 08, 6-8 PM

Saturday, April 27, 9-11 AM

Wednesday, May 8, 6-8 PM *There is a \$20 fee for this class.

Because of limited seating, preregistration will be required. Training is free to Hocking County youth, except for the May 8 class. There is a \$20 fee for this class. Cash, check, or money orders are accepted; we are not able to accept debit/credit cards.

Older youth test-out will be offered **Saturday**, **April 6**th at the Hocking County Youth Center 10am to Noon. Youth must arrive by 11AM to be tested. Testing will also be offered at Logan High School in the FFA classroom on **Friday**, **April 12**. This option is available to all youth age 15 and older as of January 1, 2024. Youth must arrange testing time with the FFA instructor.

Members may also complete the online YQCA option or attend another county training.

More information regarding YQCA will be shared in the next (April 2024) newsletter and on our website and Facebook page when available. All YQCA and out-of-county certificates are due to the Extension Office by 4 pm, May 24.

- Horse Project ID Members must upload their horse photos in 4-HOnline as part of their 2024 4-H enrollment.
- Ralph Ogle Memorial Hocking County Beef Production Grant This grant is for any 4-H or FFA Member showing a Hocking County Born Market Beef Steer or Heifer at the Hocking County Fair. To receive the \$500.00 grant, the application and letter of intent must be submitted together by the designated date.
