Hocking County 4-H Market Poultry Project

In order to exhibit and sell market chickens at the Hocking County Fair, **each member must order a minimum of six (6) chicks through Chieftain Feed and Supply (830 W. Hunter Street Logan, Ohio) by 1:00 PM on Saturday, April 19th.** The form to be used in ordering the chicks follows. The cost is \$4 per bird and you may purchase more than six, if you wish. Chicks must be paid for at the time of ordering. **Please note you will need to mail or take your form and payment to Chieftain Feed and Supply - not the Extension Office.** The delivery date for your chicks will be determined and you will be sent a reminder letter closer to the date. **No orders will be accepted after 1:00 PM on April 19, 2025.**

A pen of two broilers must weigh a minimum of 8 pounds to be eligible to sell in the Small Animal Sale during the 2025 Hocking County Fair. Exhibitors will be limited to selling **one lot of small animal(s) and one lot of large animal or two large animal lots.** A pen of two broiler chickens is considered **one lot.** Exhibitors may exhibit a total of two pens of broilers (four birds) . Exhibitors may have up to eight of each species entered in the junior fair. A pen of 2 is considered one lot. Exhibitors must be enrolled and complete in their projects to be eligible to show at the fair.

Poultry purchased/exhibited from out-of-state must meet Ohio's import laws. They must come from an NPIP flock (have NPIP hatchery papers, VS Form 9-3) or have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) from the veterinarian.
