Re: 4-H Judging

I am writing to make sure you understand what you will need to complete and bring with you to 4-H project judging on July 12. Judging will be at the Chieftain Center this year and more information will be shared closer to our judging date.

You will want to bring:

- A decorated cake or cupcake. You may decorate an actual cake or cupcake or a Styrofoam base in place of the cake.
- A display representing your learning experience in the project. Typically, the display is an educational poster. This display can also be used at the county fair. Due to time and temperature, please do not bring a decorated cake to the county fair.
- Completed project book per guidelines on page 4.

All 4-H members are required to participate in project judging or the livestock Skillathon with one project – although they are encouraged to participate in all their projects. If you are unable to attend in-person judging on July 12, please call OSU Extension Office to make an appointment for make-up judging on July 21, 23, or 23. Note that make-up judging is not eligible for project judging awards.
