

# Enrolling a Child in Ohio 4-H Programming

## Who should register and enroll a child into Ohio 4-H programming?

Only a parent or legal guardian should register and enroll a child into Ohio 4-H programming. Whoever a parent or legal guardian identifies as the “second family” in the 4-H online system will have access to the participating child’s enrollment information, so please be thoughtful on who you identify in that role. This information cannot be changed without the assistance of a county 4-H professional after the enrollment is submitted.

If a parent or legal guardian originally listed in 4-H online as a primary or secondary family can no longer legally have contact with the participating child, please contact the 4-H leader and county 4-H professional as soon as possible to provide updated information.
