Supply Drive for the Hocking Hills Inspire Shelter

A Community Action Plan for 4-H Youth – Tomorrow's Leaders in Action Today

Ryan Patton represented Hocking County 4-H at Citizenship Washington Focus this summer. With youth from five other Southeastern Ohio counties, they identified a problem affecting their counties; homelessness was the prominent issue. The group's plan won a competition sponsored by National 4-H and Farm Credit and a cash prize of \$500.

All area youth groups are encouraged to participate in the Supply Drive. Points will be given for all items donated. Donations can be dropped off at the OSU Extension Office located on the Hocking Co. Fairgrounds.

All donations to benefit the homeless in Hocking County will be given to the Hocking Hills Inspire Shelter for distribution.

The youth groups that earn the highest number of points will be awarded as follows: Highest: \$50 gift card for a pizza party, 2nd Highest: \$20 check to the youth group and 3rd Highest: \$10 check to the youth group. Winners will be notified on Monday, September 18.
