Additional Information

- Market Lambs should be born between January and March.
- Cost of lamb can vary.
- Market lambs can be wethers or ewes.
- Ewes cannot be both breeding and market.
- ➤ Lambs eat about 3-4% of their body weight in feed a day
- Lambs need room for exercise and play
- > Shelter from the elements and predators.
- > Clean straw or shavings for bedding.
- > Lambs must have a permanent scrapie identification.
